





Residency program to support the **Palestinian artistic and cultural scene** in times of crisis





Call for applications

1. THE PROGRAM

In a context of acute crisis affecting harshly the Palestinian cultural scene, the French Institute of Jerusalem has partnered with Palestinian and French counterparts to design a residency program that will organize 57 residencies (24 in Palestine and 33 in France).

This program is a continuation of the French Institute of Jerusalem long-standing action in the artistic residency field.

It aims to support Palestinian artists with diverse profiles in terms of disciplines, generations, and geographical origins. Its goal is to accompany them in the development of a research and creation project in all sectors of contemporary creation.

A first call for applications has been published in spring 2024 for 3-month residencies to be carried out at Palestinian cultural institutions venues and taking place **between** July and December 2024.

A second call for applications is now open for 3 to 6-month residencies in France to be carried out at French cultural institutions venues and will take place between January 2025 and December 2025.

For those who applied or took part in the first call, they can also reapply and take part in this second call.

This document constitutes the call for applications for the 3 to 6-month residencies in French cultural institutions between January and December 2025.

2. WHO IS IT FOR?

This program is aimed at **Palestinian artists** of **all disciplines** (visual arts, performing arts, music, writing, and cinema) **residing in Jerusalem or the West Bank** or **originally from Gaza** and living abroad, to enable them to maintain a creative activity. In particular, it seeks to promote the diversity of Palestinian artists' profiles, whether emerging or established, with an emphasis on the diversity of social and geographical contexts.

Exhibition curators are also welcome to apply.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Current or habitual residence in Jerusalem or the West Bank or originally from Gaza and having left Gaza after January 2023 (regardless of current place of residence)
- Artistic proven practice and professional experience in the relevant artistic field
- Proficiency in English and/or French
- No age limit

4. CHOICE OF RESIDENCY LOCATION

Projects proposed by applicants must necessarily align with the artistic line of the hosting organization. Applicants are invited to read carefully each host institution presentation, so as to be able to formulate their project in line with the cultural project of the residency venue (main discipline, theme addressed, technical resources required, etc.). On the application form, applicants are asked to indicate their order of preference among the possible residencies. Up to 3 choices (maximum) must be numbered in order of preference.

5. CONDITIONS OF RESIDENCY

The program includes:

- **Travel expenses** for the laureate (round trip ticket to France + internal transportation in Palestine and France + travel insurance + visa fees),
- A living allowance of 1,000 € per month,
- Accommodation and workspace provided by the partner during the residency period.

Depending on the partner's capacity, the artist may be accompanied by a partner and children if he/she wishes so. The program does not cover any expenses related to the latter's mobility and stay.

Accompanying expenses and/or production grant for a total amount of 2,500 €.

This amount will be managed by the hosting institution, and its use will be decided by mutual agreement with the artist according to the needs they express in relation with their project.

The host institution will provide professional support for the artist during the residency (mentoring, advice) and will put the artist in touch with local and national cultural players and professionals involved in contemporary creation. The resident will be invited to present their project and needs to the partner before and at the very beginning of the residency.

If possible and agreed by the artist, a public presentation/restitution session may be organized during or at the end of the residency. Expenses will be covered by the host institution.

6. SELECTION PROCESS

The selection process will be coordinated by the French Institute of Jerusalem, in collaboration with the program partners.

The French Institute of Jerusalem receives applications and assesses their eligibility.

Selection committees by disciplines will be organized. They will be composed of representatives from French and Palestinian program partners. In addition to evaluating the professional background of the applicant, particular attention will be paid to the quality of the project, the connection of the project with the host structure, and the proposed work protocol. The final selection of the resident artist will be made by the partner who will host the residency, out of a short-list established by the selection committee.

The committees will pay particular attention to gender parity among the selected applicants, as well as to the diversity of social and geographical contexts.

7. SCHEDULE

- Submission of applications: from July 10th to August 20th, 2024
- Announcement of results: mid-October
- Residency dates: 3 to 6 months between January 2025 and December 2025

To submit your application, you must:

Complete the online form using the following information:

- Project holder: general information about the artist
- . Project description: project title, brief presentation of the residency project, objectives and expected results, preferred host structures in order of preference based on the project alignment with the residency host institution (up to a maximum of 3 choices), artist's availability during the proposed residency periods
- Partners: information about any contacts and partnerships established with н. French and/or Palestinian artists and/or professionals

Upload the following documents:

- A Curriculum Vitae
- An artistic dossier/portfolio
- A project presentation note that the applicant wishes to develop in connection with the chosen host structure (maximum 3 pages)
- Optional: links to video, audio files representative of your work

L'USAGE DU MONDE 21 is a non- activist non- political association. It was established by lawyers, journalists, and filmmakers in tribute to the legacy of Nicolas Bouvier. The association aims to welcome and support filmmakers, who face obstacles in freely expressing themselves in their countries.

As part of this program, L'USAGE DU MONDE 21 has partnered with the Paris Department of Cultural Affairs, which manages artists' residencies, to welcome artists to a historic site: the former Récollets convent in the heart of Paris, offering a privileged residence in a green environment.

Residents profiles

Applicants should have produced at least one short film selected for a festival and are working on an internationally-oriented feature-length fiction film project.

Available means

Accommodation provided in a fully furnished and equipped apartment of over 40m2 of space at the Couvent des Récollets, provided by the City of Paris. The former Couvent des Récollets is located in the 10th arrondissement of Paris, close to the Gare de l'Est station, in the heart of Paris and in a historic site. The residence comprises 80 furnished studios ranging in size from 25 to 125 m2. The artist can benefit from one of these furnished studios.

Type of support provided by the place of residence

Main support elements include access to presentation sessions organized by the CNC as part of Caméra Libre. Additionally, individual professional support, both artistic and judicial, is provided for writing the project and finding partners.

Possibility of organizing a public event to present the project:

Yes, presentation of the previous film at Luxor or in a partner theater. Professional meetings for the project, depending on the dates and the progress of the project.

A shared residency is planned between three partners in Bretagne and Paris: Périphérie in Montreuil, Fondation Fiminco in Romainville and Ty Films in Mellionnec.

Périphérie supports documentary projects from production to distribution, suporting tens of films each year for editing residency. Furthermore, we organize sessions and meetings about heritage or contemporary works, particularly during the Documentary Cinema Meetings, which is our annual meeting. We also conduct educational workshops and training for professional and/or amateur audiences.

Ty Films supports documentary cinema and aims to make it accessible to the widest possible audience. It established The House of the Authors in Mellionnec in 2015 to function as a workspace, training center, and hub of exchanges and meetings. It enables us to welcome authors seeking a supportive framework for their creative work, including annual residencies and the professional training programs we organize. The variety of activities and participants at the House enhances a conducive atmosphere for exchanges and meetings. At the end of June, we host "The Meetings of the Documentary Film", four days of screenings, exchanges, and meetings.

The Fondation Fiminco has rehabilitated a former industrial site in Romainville to turn it into a space that acts as a resource for international artists and curators. This unique place currently houses the Fondation Fiminco's international artists residency, exhibition spaces and seven contemporary art galleries – Air de Paris, Galerie Sator, Galerie Jocelyn Wolff, In Situ – Fabienne Leclerc, 22,48m² Galerie, Galerie D and Quai 36 – the audiovisual production company Gingerlemon, the Laurel Parker Book gallery, bookshop, design and production workshop, the art and design school Parsons Paris, an Après Midi Lab printing lab and the reserves of the Frac Île-de-France. A shared residency is planned between three establishments, Périphérie in Montreuil, The Grec in Paris, and Fondation Fiminco in Romainville. You have the possibility of extending the residency in Mellionnec, Brittany, with the partner Ty films.

Périphérie supports documentary projects from production to distribution. It supports tens of films each year for editing residency. Furthermore, it organizes sessions and meetings focusing on heritage or contemporary works, particularly during the Documentary Cinema Meetings. Périphérie also conducts educational workshops and training sessions for both professional and/or amateur audiences.

The GREC (Groupe de Recherches et d'Essais Cinématographiques) finances and produces around fifteen first short films annually, with the support of the CNC.

Projects are selected based on scenarios or footage by professional committees. The GREC supports directors at all stages of film production, and offers workshops on scripting, editing, directing, casting, and actor direction. The Grec collaborates closely with numerous partners including technical industries, institutions such as the Museum of the History of Immigration, broadcasters, and others. The GREC, since its establishment in 1969, has produced more than 1300 short first films, including works by directors who are now recognized. These films are programmed throughout the year, broadcasted online, and featured at festivals.

The residency offers financial, technical, and artistic means to finalize your already filmed short film. The residents will be accommodated in the Fiminco Foundation studios and will benefit from:

- A grant of up to €5,000 intended to finance the finalization stages (image editing, sound editing, mixing, calibration, subtitling) and the film distribution.
- Access to image editing facilities at Périphérie. Artistic support by Périphérie and GREC during the editing stage of the film. Regular screenings of the work in the presence of the Periphery and GREC teams.
- Personalized support and consultations by professionals for the other stages of film finalization (sound editing, mixing, calibration, etc.)
- Preferential prices from GREC partners for post-production services.

After the editing and finalization of your film, you have the possibility to continue your residency in Britany into the association Ty Films.

Possibility of organizing a public event to present the project:

The GREC, Périphérie and Ty films have a vast distribution network making it possible to organize multiple screenings of the film and public engagement. These include cinemas in the Seine-Saint-Denis region, partner screening halls of the GREC like Nouvel Odéon and Saint-André-des-Arts, as well as media libraries, the Museum of the History of Immigration, French Cinematheque, the Documentary Cinematheque – Bpi, and festivals such as Jean Rouch, Rencontres du Cinéma Documentaries, Rencontres du film documentaire de Mellionnec, etc.

Since its establishment in 1990, Convivencia has developed an artistic and cultural project linked directly with world music and river itinerary in the Occitanie region. Its objective is to promote the value of both the tangible and intangible heritage of the territories it operates in. It also aims to strengthen social connections through facilitating access to the culture for the largest segment of people, particularly youth, individuals with disabilities, and those who are socially isolated. World music, which is a tool of unlocking differences and educating about citizenship, is considered to be a valuable political and social tool in times of withdrawal and hateful speech.

All its actions including concerts, participatory tours, local residencies, and more, are thought out, designed, and implemented in collaboration with multiple partners (institutions, private, associative, cultural associations, tourist organizations, etc.). For 27 years, the Convivencia Festival was known for its flagship- a summer event dedicated to world music, traveling along the Canal du Midi.

In 2010, the city of Cenon, located on the outskirts of Bordeaux, inaugurated the Rocher de Palmer, an ambitious cultural venue, with three concert halls (1,200, 650 and 450 seats), a world music resource center, and a digital studio, as well as a coworking space and an incubator dedicated to players in the cultural and creative economy.

Every season, Le Rocher de Palmer welcomes local, national or international artists in concerts. Annually, Le Rocher organizes around 160 concerts with multiple musical programs, ranging from jazz to rap, traditional music, songs, rock, electronic music, etc.





Located in a former secondary school near Paris, Artagon Pantin is a place of work, production, training and resources for artists and cultural professionals at the beginning of their career, working in all art fields. It welcomes 50 artists and professionals for 18-month promotions. Spread over more than 6,000 m2, it is committed to promoting the emergence of new and diverse voices, ideas and practices, in close collaboration with local partners and its neighbors. Throughout the year, Artagon Pantin offers training courses, meetings and events, as well as an extensive cultural program.

Artagon Pantin is part of a network of resource places run by Artagon, along with Artagon Marseille and Maison Artagon located in the Loiret region.
